

UCEAP Fall Semester Program vs. UCSC Fall Quarter

One way to understand the cost of study abroad is to **compare your program budget** to the **estimated cost of attendance at UCSC**. The table below shows a side-by-side comparison of the cost to study abroad in Seoul, Korea vs. Santa Cruz. Note the following:

- The program below takes place at [Yonsei University](#), a semester-based school. The total cost of a semester is typically more than a quarter because the program awards more credit (21~24 UC credits), and the length of the term is longer (15~20 weeks).
- Personal expenses, such as souvenirs, phones, independent travel, etc. are not included.
- UCSC costs are based on 2020-21 California Resident Fees. Non-Resident Fees are additional.
- Fall Quarter UCSC costs are sourced from the [Financial Aid website](#).
- UCEAP costs are based on 2021-22.
