

UCEAP Spring Semester vs. UCSC Winter + Spring Quarter

One way to understand the cost of study abroad is to **compare your program budget** to the **estimated cost of attendance at UCSC**. The table below shows a side-by-side comparison of the cost to study abroad in Lyon, France vs. Santa Cruz. Note the following:

- The program below takes place at [University of Lyon](#), where a spring semester runs January to May and overlaps both Winter and Spring Quarter. The total cost of this spring program is less than 2 quarters at UCSC partly because the program awards less credit (23 UC credits) than 2 quarters (30 units).
- Personal expenses, such as souvenirs, phones, independent travel, etc. are not included.
- UCSC costs are based on 2020-21 California Resident Fees. Non-Resident Fees are additional.
- Winter and Spring Quarter UCSC costs are sourced from the [Financial Aid website](#).
- UCEAP costs are based on 2021-22.
