One way to get the most out of your study abroad experience is to **plan carefully**, and this is especially important for your finances. A great way to begin your planning is to compare your program budget to the **estimated cost of attendance at UCSC**. Each program type compares differently to UCSC tuition, depending on the length of the program, accommodations, cost of living etc. If your first choice program has a higher cost difference, remember that there are many other options out there you can choose from.
